9	Carcass Judging	Competitors to judge and place four photographs in order of merit. Verbal reasons to be given to the judge. 10 minutes to look at the photos, 5 minutes to prepare reasons and 2 minutes to give reasons. White coats must be worn.
10	Nature Trail	Team of two competitors to complete a trail around the show ground as directed by the judge. It will involve identification and questions to be answered.
11	First Aid	Competitor to answer a written questionnaire and carry out practical tasks as directed by the judge. White coats must be worn.
12	Mountain Bike Challenge	Competitors to complete a course as directed. Must provide own bike and helmet.

35	Fence Erecting	Team of three members are required to erect a fence. Specification available from OFYFC website from 1st February 2019. Time allowed will be 90 minutes. Some holes will be pre-dug for you. All materials will be supplied, but you will need to bring your own tools. Please see National Rules for more details.
36	Men's Tug of War	Team of eight members with a total weight not exceeding 680kg. Suitable footwear must be worn. The deciding heat for 1st and 2nd place will be at the Main Rally. Please see National Rules for more details.
37	Ladies Tug of War	Team of eight members with a total weight not exceeding 560kg. Suitable footwear must be worn. The deciding heat for 1st and 2nd place will be at the Main Rally. Please see National Rules for more details.
38	Junior Tug of War	Team of seven to ten members, at least one male and one female in the team, with a total initial weight limit of 560kg. An additional 10kg will be added to the weight allowance for each female member up to a maximum of 600kg. Minimum age for competing is 12 years old as at 1st September 2018. The deciding heat for 1st and 2nd place will be at the Main Rally. Please see National Rules for more details.
39	Clay Pigeon Shooting	Competitors to shoot 50 sporting clays from a series of different traps. One competitor from each club in the two categories: 17 & under and 26 & under. Ages to be taken from 1st September 2018. Competitors to provide their own gun and have a shotgun licence. Please see National Rules for more details. Venue and date to be confirmed.

40	Art	Competitor to paint a picture of a 'Sporting Event' using any type of paint. Picture must be mounted on an A4 piece of card or canvas.
41	Decorative Cookery	Competitor to ice and decorate four cup cakes with the theme 'Sports Equipment'. Bought cake toppers are not allowed. They will be judged on appearance not taste.
42	Set Recipe Cookery	Competitor to make four cookies using the recipe provided. To be judged on appearance and taste. Recipe will be available on the OFYFC website from 1st February 2019.
43	Metalcraft	Competitor to make and display a house-sign to be wall mounted. Max size 50cm x 40cm. Photographs must be taken throughout the process and displayed on a single sheet of A4 card.
44	Woodwork	Competitor to make and display a wooden birdbox. Max size 30cm x 30cm. To be wall mounted (and hung in marquee). Photographs must be taken through out the making process and displayed on a single sheet of A4 card.
45	Computer Design	Competitor to design and make an A4 poster to advertise a YFC Farm Olympics event.
46	Craft	Competitor to design and make a scarf from any materials. To be judged on overall appearance and quality of stitching/knitting/crocheting etc. Maximum length 1.5m. Photographs must be taken throughout the making process and displayed on a single sheet of A4 card. Will be displayed on a mannequin.
47	Photography	Competitor to exhibit three photos taken by themselves with the theme 'My Favourite Hobby'. Photographs to be mounted on maximum A3 card.
48	Colouring	Competitors to colour in a set picture using pencils, crayons or felt tip pens. To be mounted on A4 card. Picture available on the OFYFC website from 1st February 2019.
49	Handwriting	Competitor to write a thank you letter to a speaker following a meeting in their best handwriting. To be displayed on A4 card.
50	Novelty Class	Competitor to make a model of a piece of sporting equipment using any medium they wish. It must be free standing and a maximum of 30cm x 30cm x any height.

53	Set Recipe Cookery	Competitor to make and display four squares of flapjack using the recipe provided. To be judged on appearance and taste. Recipe will be available on the OFYFC website from 1st February 2019.
54	Metalcraft	Competitor to make and display a wine rack from recycled horse shoes to hold at least six bottles of wine. Photographs must be taken throughout the process and displayed on a single sheet of A4 card.
55	Woodwork	Competitor to make and display a chopping board. Maximum size 30cm x 45cm. Photographs must be taken throughout the making process and displayed on a single sheet of A4 card.
56	Computer Design	Competitor to design an A4 poster to advertise a 'Charity Sports Match'.
57	Craft	Competitor to design and make a bow tie. Photographs must be taken throughout the making process and displayed on a single sheet of A4 card.
58	Photography	Competitor to exhibit three photos taken by themselves with the theme 'British Country Sports'. Photographs to be mounted on maximum A3 card.
59	Colouring	Competitors to colour in a set picture using pencils, crayons or felt tip pens. To be mounted on A4 card. Picture will be available on the OFYFC website from 1st February 2019.

62	Art	Competitor to paint a 'Sports Person' using any type of watercolours. Picture must be mounted on an A4 piece of card or canvas.
63	Decorative Cookery	Competitor to ice and decorate a two tiered cake to the theme of 'A Sporting Event'. Dummy cakes may be used as it will not be judged on taste. Store bought toppers are not allowed. Maximum size of bottom layer 9" (23cm) round or square.
64	Set Recipe Cookery	Competitor to make a swiss roll using the recipe provided. To be judged on appearance and taste. Recipe will be available on the OFYFC website from 1st February 2019.
65	Metalcraft	Competitor to make and display a wall mounted weather-vane. Max size 1m square. Photographs must be taken throughout the process and displayed on a single sheet of A4 card.
66	Woodwork	Competitor to make and display a wooden toilet roll holder. Photographs must be taken throughout the making process and displayed on a single sheet of A4 card.
67	Computer Design	Competitor to design an A4 poster advertising a gala dinner with an Olympic Sportsperson speaking after dinner. Area allowed is A4.
68	Craft	Competitor to design and make a waterproof bag to take camping. Rough size 50cm x 30cm to have multiple pockets for towel, toiletries etc. Photographs must be taken throughout the making process and displayed on a single sheet of A4 card.
69	Photography	Competitor to exhibit three photos taken by themselves with the theme 'Action Sporting Shots'. Photographs to be mounted on maximum A3 card.
70	Colouring	Competitors to colour in a set picture using pencils, crayons or felt tip pens. To be mounted on A4 card. Picture will be available on the OFYFC website from 1st February 2019.
71	Handwriting	Competitor to write a limerick in their best handwriting. No shorter than five verses and no larger than A4.
72	Novelty Class	Competitor to make a model of a piece of sporting equipment using any medium they wish. It must be free standing and a maximum of 30cm x 30cm x any height.

EXHIBITION - Open

73	Scrapbook	Make and display your club scrapbook detailing activities from May 2018 to May 2019. One Junior and one Senior entry.
74	Publicity Board	Each club to make and display a 4ft x 8ft (120cm x 240cm) wooden publicity board advertising the rally. It must be up and the Committee notified of its position by 13th May 2018. Wording to be included will be available on the OFYFC website from 1st February 2019. One Junior and one Senior entry.
75	Yearbook Cover	Competitor to design and make a suitable A5 year book cover for the 2019/2020 year book. This can be done on a computer or by hand. One Junior and one Senior entry allowed but will be judged overall for actual yearbook cover choice.
76	Scarecrows	Competitors to design and make a scarecrow with the theme 'County Staff'. It must be free standing or able to be attached to a post. They will be displayed outside the Exhibition tent. Photographs must be taken through out the making process and displayed on a single sheet of A4 card. The member of County Staff must be declared by 1st April 2019 to avoid duplication - first come, first served. One Junior and one Senior entry.
77	Video	Each Junior and Senior club to produce a promotional video to attract new members to YFC. It must be no longer than 3 minutes and should be suitable to be watched by everyone. It must include sound. Details on format will be available on the OFYFC website from 1st February 2019.
78	The Cube	An Exhibit to depict the theme of Children's Television. This theme can be interpreted in any way that the club sees fit. It is required to exhibit 5 crafts. 1 craft from each of the following: Craft 1 - Floral Art (Any item using cut flowers and accessories in a suitable container), Craft 2 – Cookery/Baking (This craft will be tasted so must be covered with cling film), Craft 3 – Textile Handicraft (must include British Wool - Knitwear, Tailored, Crochet for example), Craft 4 – Natural Handicraft (Any item using wood, metal, clay, glass, stone or shell for example), Craft 5 – Art (An item that could include photography, a graphic or a picture in any medium). Each whole Exhibit to have a MAXIMUM WIDTH of 1 metre at any given point and a MAXIMUM DEPTH of 1 metre and MAXIMUM HEIGHT of 1 metre. Any exhibit exceeding the maximum measurements will be disqualified. The measurement will be from the outside edges of the external walls of the exhibit. (i.e. Make your exhibit slightly smaller than the maximum dimensions). Any accessories or drapes used on the outside of the external walls of the cube will be included in the overall measurement of the exhibit. The external walls will be taken into account for the attractiveness of the exhibit marks and so should be covered to compliment the overall exhibit. The exhibit must have 3 walls. One Junior and one Senior entry.

79	Floral Art	Competitor to produce a flower arrangement with the title 'My Great Hobby'. Maximum display area for each competitor must not exceed 60cm wide x 60cm deep x optional height. Exhibits to be composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories. Exhibit to be viewed from the front. Competitors own backboard and base boards are allowed and must adhere to the size limitations. The reverse of the boards must be white and clean and tidy. All flowers, foliage and equipment to be provided by the competitor. White coats must be worn. Time allowed - 1 hour. Please see National Rules for more details.
80	Eating Competition	Two teams of four competitors to complete an eating challenge in the fastest time.
81	Team of Two	Two competitors to work together to decorate a cake. One to be blindfolded and the other giving instructions. Maximum time allowed 30 minutes and all materials must be provided by competitors.
82	Food Preparation	Competitor to make and cook two pancakes. The gas rings, flour, eggs and milk will be provided but competitor must provide any other ingredients and equipment. White coats must be worn. 20 minutes allowed for preparation, cooking and presentation.
83	Art	Competitor to decorate a paving slab using chalks to the theme of 'Sports or Sporting Events'. Paving slab to be provided but competitor to provide chalks. Time allowed 30 minutes.
84	Identification	Competitor to identify various cuts of meat.
85	Soap Carving	Competitor to carve a piece of soap into a cartoon character. Soap will be provided. Time allowed 20 minutes.

86	Floral Art	Competitor to produce a flower arrangement with the title 'Great Craftsmanship'. Maximum display area for each competitor must not exceed 60cm wide x 60cm deep x optional height. Exhibits to be composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories. Exhibit to be viewed from all sides. Backboards are not allowed. All flowers, foliage and equipment to be provided by the competitor. White coats must be worn. Time allowed - 1 hour. Please see National Rules for more details.
87	Eating Competition	One team of five competitors to complete an eating challenge in the fastest time.
88	Team of Two	Two competitors to work together to decorate a cake. One to be blindfolded and the other giving instructions. Maximum time allowed 30 minutes and all materials must be provided by competitors.
89	Food Preparation	Competitor to make a filled omelette. Four eggs will be provided but competitor must provide their own equipment and fillings (these may be pre-cut/cooked). White coats must be worn. 20 minutes allowed for preparation, cooking and presentation.
90	Art	Competitor to decorate a paving slab using chalks to the theme of 'Sports or Sporting Events'. Paving slab to be provided but competitor to provide chalks. Time allowed 30 minutes.
91	Identification	Blindfolded competitor to identify different items through taste or smell.
92	Soap Carving	Competitor to carve a piece of soap into a turtle. Soap will be provided. Time allowed 20 minutes.

93	Floral Art	Competitor to produce a flower arrangement with the title 'Great Inventions that changed the world'. Maximum display area for each competitor must not exceed 60cm wide x 60cm deep x optional height. Exhibits to be composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories. Exhibit to be viewed from the front. Competitors own backboard and base boards are allowed and must adhere to the size limitations. The reverse of the boards must be white and clean and tidy. All flowers, foliage and equipment to be provided by the competitor. White coats must be worn. Time allowed - 1 hour. Please see National Rules for more details.
94	Eating Competition	One team of five competitors to complete an eating challenge in the fastest time.
95	Team of Two	Two competitors to work together to decorate a cake. One to be blindfolded and the other giving instructions. Maximum time allowed 30 minutes and all materials must be provided by competitors.
96	Food Preparation	Competitor to make five and cook two beef burgers. The mince and gas cooker will be provided but competitor must provide their own equipment/flavourings. White coats must be worn. 20 minutes allowed for preparation, cooking and presentation.
97	Art	Competitor to decorate a paving slab using chalks to the theme of 'Sports or Sporting Events'. Paving slab to be provided but competitor to provide chalks. Time allowed 30 minutes.
98	Identification	Blindfolded competitor to identify different items though taste or smell.
99	Soap Carving	Competitor to carve a piece of soap into a flower. Soap will be provided. Time allowed 20 minutes.

PRACTICAL - Open

100	Tiling	Team of two competitors to tile area as directed by the judge. Maximum time allowed 1 hour. Materials will be provided but competitors must bring their own tools. One Junior and one Senior entry.
101	Bale decorating	Team of three competitors to dress a round bale into a character. Maximum time allowed 45 mins. Bale will be provided but competitors must bring their own tools. Electrical tools are not allowed, and the bale must not be hurt during this exercise! One Junior and one Senior entry.
102	Ready Steady Cook	Team of three competitors (one 16yrs or under, one 21yrs or under and one 26yrs or under) to prepare and display four courses for the Rare Breeds Survival Trust (RBST) Gala Dinner. The meal should promote a rare or native breed as listed in the RBST watchlist 2018-19. The menu must include at least one sweet and one savoury course. Each course will be required to serve two people. A drink does not count as a course. Teams must ensure each course involves a cooked element, prepared from raw ingredients. A table and two butane gas stoves will be provided, and the Competitors to provide the ingredients and all the necessary equipment. Recipe details must be available throughout the session for the judge's inspection. Time allowed - 1 hour. Please see national rules for more details.
103	Obstacle Race	Two teams of eight competitors (4 Juniors and 4 Seniors) to complete a timed obstacle course in main arena. Team must include 2 girls. Fastest time wins.
104	Floats	Each Senior club to design and build a float to the theme 'Sporting Events'. The themes must be declared by April 1st 2019 to avoid duplication - first come, first served.
105	Go Karts	Each Junior club to design and build a Go-Kart to the theme 'Racing Tractors'. A team of six members will race the Go-Karts in the main ring. Maximum of 100 points awarded for each section a) go-kart and fancy dress and b) position in the race.
106	Raffle Tickets	Each club to sell raffle tickets for the prize draw. Tickets to be provided. More details available on the OFYFC website from 1st February 2019.
107	Fashion Class	Team of five to dress up one of their team as a sportsperson with equipment, using newspaper, string and cellotape. Maximum time allowed 30 minutes. Clubs to provide all materials. There are to be no pre-made articles. One Junior and one Senior entry.
108	Auctioneering	Each competitor will be required to auction one lot. Some may be agricultural and others not. The Competitor will have 10 minutes to prepare. The judge/steward will choose the one item at random from the four available for the competitor to auction. Competitors at the Rally will not be eligible to watch other competitors until after they have competed. Time allowed per lot sold - up to 5mins. One Junior and one Senior entry.
