


*We shall soon have a new committee in place ready for the organisation of the many sports, competitions and events that shall be taking place over the next year, details of which shall be announced soon!!*

*The senior county quiz which is always a calendar favourite is now well under way for the year with only a few rounds left before the results are announced.*


