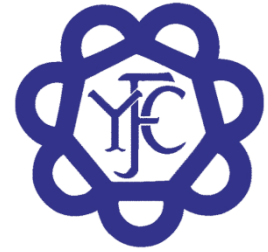

2013 Winter Newsletter

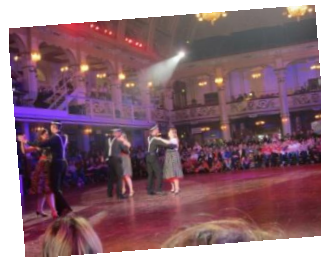

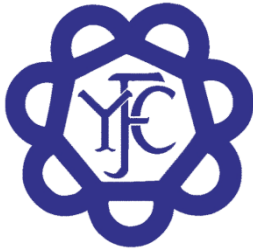
Mike Jefferies Development Fund

As ever we are planning fundraising events throughout the year for the Mike Jefferies Development Fund.

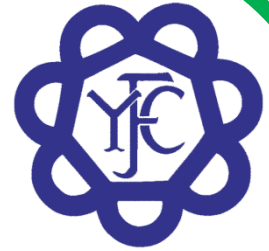
